

## 2017 Legislative Session

### **March 2017**

The complete Bill Draft Request (BDR) list for the 2017 Legislative Session is now available on the Legislature's website ([www.leg.state.nv.us](http://www.leg.state.nv.us)). The BDRs/bills listed below are being tracked by PERS staff for potential impact to the Retirement System. Once a BDR is introduced as a bill and the language is available, the Retirement Board will determine their position on the bill which staff will then post. This list will be updated monthly.

#### Assembly Bills

Assembly Bill 71 (BDR #429) – State Controller – Revises provisions governing public employees' retirement.

#### Senate Bills

Senate Bill 26 (BDR #418) – Senate Committee on Government Affairs – Makes certain changes concerning governmental entities that contract with or invest in companies that boycott Israel. The Board took a neutral position on this bill at their March 16, 2017, meeting.

Senate Bill 217 (BDR #842) – Senate Minority Leader – Revises provisions governing the Public Employees' Retirement Board. This bill changes the composition of the Retirement Board and increases the number of board members to nine. The Board took a position in opposition to this bill at their March 16, 2017, meeting.

Senate Bill 297 (BDR #843) – Senate Minority Leader – Revises provisions governing public employees' retirement.

Senate Bill 384 (BDR #506) – Senator Ratti – Provides for the confidentiality of certain information in the records and files of public employers and public employee retirement systems.
